LEGO® Crocodile Facts

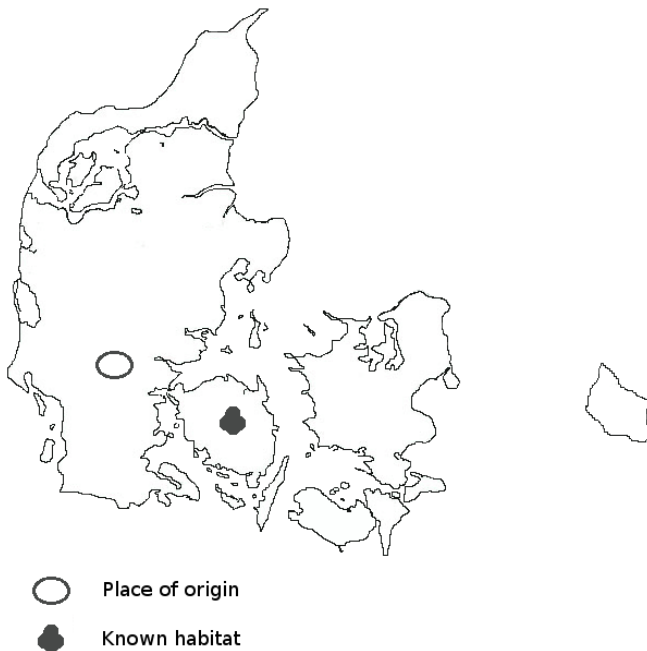
Like the true crocodiles, the alligators and caiman's the infamous LEGO® Crocodile is a member of their order **Crocodylia**. Belonging to the family **Crocodylegoae**.

Contrary to popular belief the LEGO® Crocodile is not a danger to humans. As it's primary food in the wild consists of LEGO® men, or parts thereof. The LEGO® Crocodile will only bite or show aggression when angered or provoked.

As LEGO® men are slow and dimwitted creatures the LEGO® Crocodile has never had to develop any hunting abilities. Rather the LEGO® Crocodile is a sedentary animal that much prefers to amble aimlessly around, only using minimal effort to avoid walking in to obstacles, or preferably bask in the sun.

It is widely believed that the LEGO® Crocodile originates at the LEGO® plant in Billund, Denmark. Today however the only known habitat of the LEGO® Crocodile is in Odense, Denmark. Specifically at the Mærsk building at the SDU Odense campus. Occasional sightings have however been reported as far away as Brands passage.
